## Woo WishList - Easy WooCommerce WishList

## Introduction

**Woo Wishlist - WooCommerce Wishlist** Offers for your visitors a chance to add the products of your Woocommerce store to a wishlist page where they can purchase product later. Adding product to the wishlist is easy and convenient. Users can share their wishlist on Social media, by sharing wishlist on Social Media brings potential customers.

#### Features:-

- Removes product from Wishlist automatically.
- The position of "Add to Wishlist" button on product page.
- "Add to Wishlist" Button or Link to the product page.
- Predefined icons for "Add to Wishlist" button where you can select custom colours for it.
- Redirect to Wishlist page after adding items to the Wishlist.
- A user can create Public or Private list.
- Auto-expire list (by default list will be stored till 15 days, for Guest User)

#### Installation

#### 1) WordPress Plugin Uploader

- 1. Log in to your WordPress Admin panel
- 2. Navigate to Plugin -> Add New
- 3. Click Upload.
- 4. Click Choose File and select the **Woo Wishlist Woocommerce Wishlist** plugin package zip.
- 5. Click Install Now.
- 6. Complete the installation process as directed by WordPress and Activate the plugin.

OR

#### 2) FTP

- 1. Decompress the .zip file you downloaded from Codecanyon.
- 2. Find the Woo Wishlist Woocommerce WishList folder (this directory is created when you unzip the file).
- 3. Upload the Woocommerce Shopping List folder to your wp-content/plugins directory.
- 4. Navigate to your Control Panel: Plugins.
- 5. Under Woocommerce Shopping List, click Activate Panel: Plugin.




## **Quick Start**

This is an overview of features available to a store manager with WooCommerce Wishlists.

## **Wishlist Settings**

Settings for the extension can be found under the Wishlists tab on the WooCommerce Settings page.





## 1. Shipping List Display Option

#### 1.1 Lists Creation:-

This option controls the ability for Guest users to create lists. If you want anyone, with or without an account to create lists, Select and click on the checkbox and manually can set the expiration of the list.






If checkbox left blank then the wishlist buttons will be hidden from Guest User and User must sign in products and will require the user to log in before they can create a list.

## 1.2 Shop list page

This option controls whether the shop page list is added to the primary menu. (Note that this will only work if you have set any menu at primary location)


## 1.3 Button type

When the Add To Wishlist content is displayed on a single product, it can either be a text link, or a button which looks similar to the Add to Cart button. Choose the type you would like to use here. Button Type:






## 1.4 Add to list text

#### 1.4.1 Text

Enter the text you would like to display for the "Add to Shop List" button or link. This text will be displayed on the Single Product.



#### 1.4.2 Icon


ShopList has icons built in for the link type, where you can select a custom colour for it.



## 1.4.3 Text + Icon



Enter the text you would like to display with an icon for the "Add to Shop List" button or link. This text will be displayed on the Single Product.



#### 1.5 Message on cart

If this option is enabled, it will display a message on Cart Page when added from a shopping list.

## 2. Shopping List Behaviour Options

With these options, you can set up products to be removed from a shopping list if purchased, and you can determine what the order status is when they should be removed.

#### Remove item


- Enable this to remove items from shopping list after order completion.
- If set to "Let the user decide", it will add a checkbox to create a list from where a user can control item deletion.



## 3. Shopping List Sharing Options

4.1.1. Select Add to Wish List on Product Page.










